Basic Safety and Health Policy for FY 2023

2. With a compliance-oriented mindset, provide a comfortable environment where everyone can work safely, efficiently, and actively through daily communication.
3. Develop the safety and health management system, ensure control over safety and health management, push forward the digital transformation of construction, and reduce risks by leveraging remote control.
4. Ensure hygiene and health management measures are implemented, prevent diseases, and promote measures to prevent infections with COVID-19.
5. Make sure that employees fully understand revisions of laws and regulations related to their jobs (e.g., laws and regulations concerning scaffolds, chemical materials, and asbestos) and have them comply with such revised laws and regulations.
6. Ensure that employees fully understand measures to prevent the reoccurrence of an occupational accident or incident, public accident, and on-site inspection by Labor Standards Office through OJT.
